here is only so much you can do to improve upon the modern hunting rifle. Converting wood, steel, brass and bullets to electronics and laser beams is not going to win many hearts and minds. So how do you compare, how do you judge, how do you decide which rifle represents the best in any one year?

Rifles - BLASER R8

Truth be told, there are no consistent criteria, no standard benchmarks. Selecting a winner hinges on feelings, hunches and esthetics as much as engineering and statistics. Yet all those things came together this year for us gun aficionados at Sporting Classics when we chose the Blaser R8 as recipient of our 2010 Rifles Award of Excellence.

Somehow the Blaser engineers have managed to combine just the right proportions of innovation, engineering and design with just the right classic traditions and esthetics in producing the lightning-fast R8. Unlike some new firearms, the R8 doesn't sacrifice classic lines for the sake of novelty. Yet it pushes hard against convention with its unique dropout trigger/magazine; it's switch barrel, modular design; it's unusual straight-pull bolt and its strong, rotary locking lugs. The removable trigger and cocking mechanism make it one of the safest bolt-action hunting rifles in the world. And, of critical importance to hunters, its total engineering and precision manufacturing make it one of the most accurate, out-of-the-box rifles in history. - Ron Spomer
